Feeding Instructions:

Introduce gradually at 30gms per day until all cattle are eating, and only after then, feed 2-3 times weekly. For more detail feeding rates go to page 2 and 3.

Ingredients:

Barley 12%, Wheat 14%, Lupins (NL), Vegetable Oil, Limestone, Dical Phos, Rock Phosphorous - palfos, Salt (Sodium Chloride, Cattle Premix).

WARNING - CONTAINS UREA

Directions for use:

Keep dry as when wet, urea could become soluble and lead to urea toxicity. Introduce slowly and always ensure adequate "gut-fill" of forage before introducing feed supplements (this product at a lower inclusion rate for one week before going to recommended rate). Forage should be provided with the ration or offered ad-lib.

Precautions:

Feeding this product to horses or other equines may be fatal.
